#### Siphona urbana or geniculata?

In Andersen's 1996 book "The Siphonini (Diptera: Tachinidae) or Europe" he made several changes to the names of Siphona spp., which have proved a bit confusing. The changes (and subsequent reversions) illustrate a few nice aspects of modern taxonomy and so I thought I would write a little piece on what happened.

Every species is based on what's called a type specimen – ideally a specimen that the author considers to be the archetypal individual, which he uses to describe what the species looks like – a holotype. Later on if anyone wants to revise a group or they want to be absolutely sure of their identification they can hunt down the holotype and compare it to their own specimens, safe in the knowledge that the holotype is the definitive example of the species. In fact I have at times joked that the only 'correctly' identified specimen is the holotype – anything else is






Eriothrix rufomaculata

Current distribution



2008 distribution











Gymnosoma rotundatum

Distribution up to 2000






